

Locker Room Refresh Update

Members and Guests-

For those of you who utilize our locker rooms at the DLCCC you know that the condition of this space is in significant need of repairs and upgrading. The flooring and wall covering in the locker rooms and shower areas is beyond its useful life and has become very difficult to clean and maintain. Over the past several months we have been looking at options to address this issue, gathering feedback from members and our custodial staff and obtaining pricing of various options.

Our locker rooms are used by a wide array of individuals and groups. Priorities include creating a more pleasant environment for our members and guests that is highly durable, easy to clean/maintain and affordable given other significant capital needs that exist. Our board of directors has approved a plan to proceed with removing the existing flooring and wall covering and replacing with an epoxy paint with grip/grit, refurbishing ceramic tiles in showers, replacing lockers, adding new benches, stools/shower stools and ceiling fans for improved ventilation. The total estimated costs for all three locker rooms is estimated at \$150,000. We have begun fundraising to help defray these costs and have already received more than 50% of this amount which will allow us to proceed and complete the project as funds become available.

The first phase of this project will be to start in the private changing area (family locker rooms) and we expect that work to begin in early August. We intentionally chose this time when the pool is closed, as the majority of use in this area is pool related. Lockers will be replaced in stages starting with those in the worst condition. Once this area is completed, we will continue on with the women's and men's locker rooms so that everyone will have an option to utilize a locker room throughout the project. We hope to complete all three areas over the next few months depending on our fundraising progress and will provide updated communication along the way.
